4.7.2 c) Selection of Rating of Meter Protection Devices

Reinsert phrase 'must be located adjacent to or incorporated in the MSB' which was accidently omitted when revising SIRs with the separation of the Annexure for metering.

4.10 Service Neutral Links

Clarified introductory sentence to ensure service neutral link is obligatory.

5.2.2 Underground Supply from Underground Mains

Changed acceptable length of a special service to 30m from 10m. Added sentence to ensure it also complies to all other conditions of **Section 2 – Underground Services**.

8.6.13.1 Conductor Size Exception Clause

Updated worked example and accompanying table, to meet maximum acceptable voltage. Added reference to voltage as per AS 4777.
